A. ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The quality that enables people to start a new business or vigorously and innovatively to expand an existing one (Harper 1983).

Consists in doing things that are not generally done in the ordinary course of business routine.

...is a mindset. It is a thinking process. It is a way of looking at the environment. (A. Ferreria)

"Entrepreneurship is the process of identifying, developing, and bringing a vision to life. The vision may be an innovative idea, an opportunity, or simply a better way to do something. The end result of this process is the creation of a new venture, formed under conditions of risk and considerable uncertainty."

B. ENTREPRENEUR

- An entrepreneur is someone who perceives an opportunity and creates an organization to pursue it. Bygrave (1997)
- "One who undertakes a commercial enterprise with a chance of profit or loss" (1991, Hawkins, J.M., The Oxford Reference Dictionary, Clarendon Press, Oxford)
- Entrepreneurship is an expression of our humanness. To be human is to be created in the image of God. The world is a fallen order (ongoing state of deterioration). Entrepreneurship is a redeeming and innovative activity. To restore, to do something new. It has an economic component.

- or producing an old one in a new way;
